LONG-TERM CARE NAVIGATION SERVICE COMING SUMMER 2016

Through our annual planning, we assess both the external and internal environments surrounding the organization's mission. During our evaluation, we found a great need in our community for resources to help families who are researching long-term care options for themselves, as well as for their family members.

Families are experiencing great amounts of stress and confusion when trying to navigate through the vast amount of information. Currently, for-profit organizations are the only option for assistance, and these for-profit organizations receive funding from the facilities they refer people to. HELP Adult Services wants families to avoid this by providing impartial options.

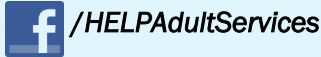
